Vacation Bible School July 27, 29, and 31, 2020

Physical Distancing Plan

We are using the term Physical Distancing instead of Social Distancing because we aim to be socially intimate with one another while still maintaining a safe physical distance to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Masks are required for all people 4 years and older participating in this event as compliant with Hoffmantown Church mask policy as well as current NM Health Orders. Gloves will be worn by all volunteers and staff members who are handing out items to the public.

Family Registration:

1. Families will park in front of Building B.
2. Families will approach the building from the north patio.
3. Each family will be offered a pump of sanitizer for each member of their party.
4. Each member of the family will be checked for a fever using a touch-less thermometer.
5. Families will enter the building.
6. A registration attendant will ask for family name and hand them their bag for the evening.
7. Bottled water will be given to each person by a volunteer.
8. The family will then proceed into the Worship Center.

Family Seating:

1. A Physical Distancing Volunteer Team will be in the Worship Center helping families select suitable seating.
2. Each family will select a square on the floor to participate from.

During the Event:

1. Families will remain in their square unless they are going to the restroom.
2. Families will participate in games and activities within their family unit only.
3. Masks will be worn the whole time.

Following the Event:

1. Families will depart through doors 4-7 at the rear of the Worship Center and continue outside.
2. Each person will receive an individually packaged frozen treat as they exit.
3. Families can take their treat with them or they may elect to sit on the patio or in the grove and eat it while remaining 6 feet from other families.

Restrooms:

Restrooms will be available in the church. Each restroom will be limited to 4 people at a time. Restrooms will be regularly disinfected throughout the event.

Volunteer Check In:

Takes place at a table

1. An attendant will mark each volunteer off a list.
2. Each volunteer will pick up their own safety vest on Monday. Vests will be returned at the end of the week to ensure each volunteer only wears the same vest all week.
3. Each volunteer must provide their own mask.
