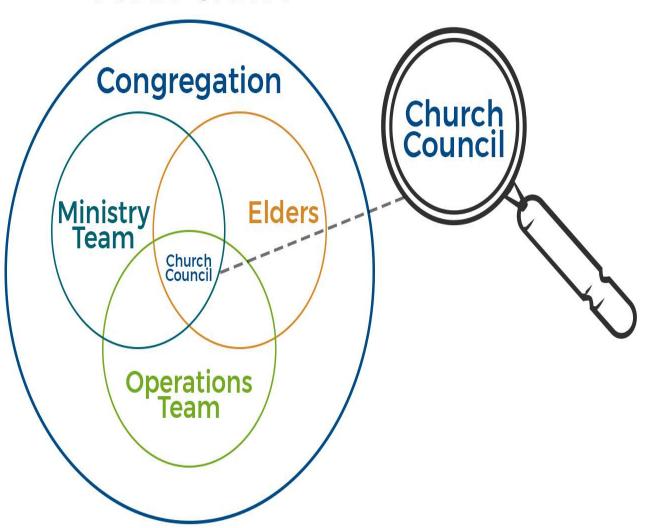

## Finance Committee

#### **Some Significant Finance Committee Activities**

- External CPA annual review of Hoffmantown financial records
  - Reported in the Compass and Compass+
  - The CPA firm CRI reported that the church is financially healthy despite issues related to COVID-19. HC was commended for reducing costs, taking advantage of the PPP and preserving cash.
- FY 2021-22 Budget Process Ongoing
  - FC working with the Church leadership and the Personnel Committee
  - Proposed budget will be available in June at least two weeks before the vote

## Finance Committee

#### **Some Significant Finance Committee Activities**

- The FC reviews income and expenditures in detail monthly
  - A report is given to the Church Council and Leadership monthly
  - A summary financial report is in the Compass+ monthly
- Balances as of January 31, 2021
  - Reserve Fund: \$588,404
  - Special Missions Fund: \$133,261
  - Benevolence: \$87,313
  - Property Improvement: \$75,928
- The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, P.L. 116-260, gave the church approximately \$148,000 in tax credits that will be applied to employment taxes at about \$2,000/month

The Finance Committee would like to commend the Church Leadership and Operations Directorate for ensuring that expenditures do not exceed income.

## Facilities and Land Sale

- The land sale has hit some unexpected complications
  - The buyer has asked the church for a closing date extension. They cannot arrange financing because equity markets have frozen lending on new senior living construction.
  - In anticipation of the land sale, the parcel is now subject to property tax, that the church will have to pay in the interim
- Land Sale Working Group is working to resolve both issues

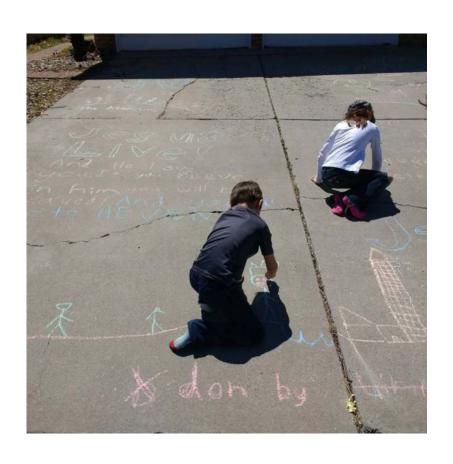
# Mission Ministry

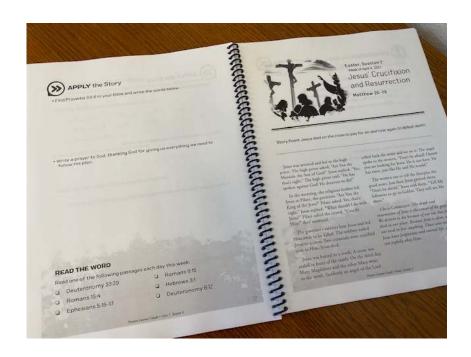
